## PASSENGER VEHICLES

### MAJOR

1. Motor or engine.
2. Trunk floor pan or rear section and roof.
3. Frame or any portion thereof (except frame horn), or, in the case of a unitized body, the supporting structure which serves as the frame, except when it is a part of the trunk floor pan, or rear section and roof.
4. Cowl, firewall, or any portion thereof.
5. Roof assembly.

### MINOR

1. Each door allowing entrance to or egress from the passenger compartment.
2. Hood.
3. Each front fender or each rear fender when used with a rear section and roof.
4. Deck lid, tailgate or hatchback (whichever is present).
5. Each quarter panel.
6. Each bumper.
7. T-tops, moon roof, or whichever is present.
8. Transmission (notarized bill of sale required).

## TRUCK, TRUCK TYPE OR BUS TYPE VEHICLES

### MAJOR

1. Motor or engine.
2. Transmission or trans-axle.
3. Frame or any portion thereof (except frame horn), or, in the case of a unitized body, the supporting structure which serves as the frame.
4. Cab.
5. Cowl, firewall, or any portion thereof.
6. Roof assembly.
7. Cargo compartment floor panel or passenger compartment floor plan.

### MINOR

1. Each door allowing entrance to or egress from the passenger compartment.
2. Hood.
3. Grill, except on one ton or smaller trucks.
4. Each bumper.
5. Each front fender.
6. Roof panel and rear cab panel.
7. Each rear fender or side panel.
8. Pickup box.
9. Body or bed.

## MOTORCYCLES

1. Engine or motor.
2. Transmission or trans-axle.
3. Frame.
4. Front fork.
5. Crankcase.
