

REASON FOR REQUESTING TEMPORARY OPERATION PERMIT (check one):

- Title Not Available for timely Registration.** Copy of a dealer's invoice or a notarized bill of sale is required. If the title is in the possession of the previous owner's lien holder, the bill of sale should include the name and address of the lienor (Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-3-118(b)). A registration certificate identifying the current owner is required in either case. Please provide details below.
- Casual and Isolated Sale.** The vehicle was purchased from an individual (casual and isolated sale) and will be transported to the county clerk's office to be registered. Copy of a notarized bill of sale or properly assigned title is required.
- Out-of-State Resident/Transport.** Must provide properly reassigned title, dealer's invoice, or notarized bill of sale and proper identification. Please provide details below.
- Salvage or Similar Type of Document.** Previously damaged or wrecked vehicle. Please provide details below.
