

Driver License Extension Request

Use this form to request a one-year extension of your driver license if you will be out-of-state when it expires.

- Commercial driver licenses cannot be extended.
- Your license must not be suspended, revoked, or cancelled.
- You must not have outstanding licensing fees.
- Only one 12-month extension will be granted, then you must renew your license.
- Driving privileges may be extended for enhanced driver license (EDL) holders, but the document would not be valid for entry at any land or sea border crossings after the original expiration date.
- Carry the extension with your expired license.
